

Dear Judge Remke:

The Supreme Court in the above-entitled proceeding entered an Order filed November 19, 2012 requiring the respondent to take and pass the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination within one (1) year of the effective date of the Supreme Court order.

On December 12, 2012 the Office of Probation mailed notice to the respondent at 79899 Grasmere Ave, Indio, CA 92203, which was his Membership Records address at that time, reminding the respondent of the provisions of the Supreme Court Order. The envelope containing said notice was not returned to this office by the postal authorities.
