On June 9, 2010, respondent **Howard Ronald Gottlieb** filed a motion for extension of time to take and pass the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination (“MPRE”) and complete the State Bar’s Ethics School (“motion for extension”).¹ The motion for extension was based on respondent’s inability to attend either the MPRE or Ethics School due to chronic health problems.


On June 14, 2010, Office of Probation Supervising Attorney Terrie Goldade filed a response. In its response, the Office of Probation did not object to an extension of time for respondent to take and pass the MPRE and complete Ethics School, but requested that such an extension be limited to one year.

Good cause having been shown, respondent’s motion for extension of time within which he must prove passage of the MPRE and completion of the State Bar’s Ethics School to the

¹ In the motion for extension, respondent requests an extension of time to pass the “State Bar Ethics Exam.” The court presumes that respondent is actually referring to the MPRE.

Office of Probation is **GRANTED**. Respondent is **ORDERED** to provide proof of passage of the MPRE and completion of the State Bar's Ethics School to the Office of Probation within one year of the date of this order.²

² Considering the facts and circumstances of the present matter, the court declines to extend any of the other conditions of respondent's reprobation. However, if he has not already done so, respondent is still required to file his final quarterly report (due June 9, 2010) with the Office of Probation.


