On May 29, 2007, the State Bar of California, Office of the Chief Trial Counsel, (“State Bar”) by and through Deputy Trial Counsel Kimberly Anderson, filed and served a motion for involuntary inactive enrollment pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6007(b)(2) and rule 410, *et seq.*, Rules Proc. of State Bar. On June 20, 2007, the State Bar filed supplemental information concerning the proper service of its May 29, 2007, filing. Respondent did not respond to the motion.

A hearing on the State Bar’s motion was held on July 27, 2007. Deputy Trial Counsel Brooke Shafer appeared for the State Bar. Although respondent received notice, he did not appear for the hearing.

Having considered the State Bar’s contentions, the court **GRANTS** the motion. There is clear and convincing evidence that the Los Angeles Superior Court has issued an order assuming jurisdiction over respondent’s law practice pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6190 (Order filed on May 22, 2007, in *In the Matter of the Assumption of Jurisdiction over the Law Practice of Richard A. Brubaker*, Los Angeles Superior Court case no. BS108202) which is still in effect and does not provide for any exceptions.

Accordingly, **IT IS ORDERED** that, effective three days after service of this order, respondent Richard A. Brubaker is inactively enrolled as a member of the State Bar of California.
