
After thorough consideration of the parties’ pleadings, the court issues the following orders:

1. Good cause having been shown, respondent’s request to extend the time within which she must prove passage of the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination (“MPRE”) to the Office of Probation is **GRANTED**. Respondent is **ORDERED** to provide proof of passage of the MPRE to the Office of Probation on or before January 14, 2012.¹

¹ As noted by the Office of Probation, respondent may take the MPRE in Florida.

2. No good cause having been shown, the remainder of the requested relief contained within respondent's Request for Modification is **DENIED**.
