In the Matter of THOMAS LAURANCE HYATT

a Member of the State Bar of California

Since respondent Thomas Laurance Hyatt, State Bar Number 152719, has been convicted of violating Vehicle Code section 23152, subdivision (a), a felony that may or may not involve moral turpitude, and Penal Code section 12021, subdivision (a)(1), a felony, under the authority of rule 9.10(a), California Rules of Court, it is ordered pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6102 that respondent be suspended from the practice of law effective October 16, 2009, pending final disposition of this proceeding. It is further ordered that respondent comply with rule 9.20, California Rules of Court, and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 days, respectively, after the effective date of this suspension.

The review department reserves the moral turpitude classification of Penal Code section 12021, subdivision (a)(1). The parties are invited to file briefs on or

before October 6, 2009 addressing the issue of whether or not a violation of this section involves moral turpitude per se.
