
On February 19, 2014, Respondent filed a motion to eliminate the medical condition of her probation, requiring her to obtain psychiatric or psychological help from a duly licensed psychiatrist or other mental health professional and provide reports to the Office of Probation of such treatments. Attached to the motion is a declaration from Respondent's psychotherapist, dated November 26, 2013, stating that he has determined that Respondent's course of therapy has been successfully completed and should be terminated.

On February 21, 2014, the Office of Probation filed a response to the motion, agreeing that the condition of probation should be terminated but complaining that, although the office had been notified on several occasions by Respondent and her attorney of the doctor's conclusion after November 26, 2013, the motion was not filed by Respondent's counsel until February 2014.

GOOD CAUSE APPEARING, Respondent's motion is granted. The condition of probation is deleted, effective November 26, 2013.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
