On April 26, 2011, Respondent W. Iain Elder Levie (Respondent) and the State Bar filed a joint Modification of Stipulation filed November 12, 2008. In this requested modification of the prior stipulation, the parties requested that paragraph (9) on page 5 of the original stipulation be deleted as a condition of probation. That paragraph ostensibly requires Respondent to comply with the conditions of probation "imposed in the underlying criminal matter" and to so declare in his quarterly probation reports to the Office of Probation. The parties jointly state that this condition of probation was checked by them by mistake and needs to be deleted because there was no underlying criminal matter.

GOOD CAUSE APPEARING, the court hereby modifies the stipulation filed November 12, 2008, and the accompanying order by this court, to delete, *nunc pro tunc*, the above condition of probation.
