**TO ALL PARTIES AND COUNSEL IN THE ABOVE-ENTITLED MATTER:**

On November 14, 2012, respondent Chesterfield Adams Spahr requested to modify a probation condition. Specifically, he asked that the drug and alcohol testing requirement be modified during his travel in December 2012 and January 2013.

The Office of Probation of the State Bar of California has not filed a response to respondent's motion, which is not yet due until December 19, 2012.

The court will issue a ruling in light of the time sensitivity in this matter. The court finds that respondent's request is consistent with protecting the public, his successful rehabilitation, and maintaining the integrity of the legal profession.


GOOD CAUSE APPEARING, respondent's motion is **GRANTED** in that his monthly drug and alcohol testing requirement is modified for the month of January 2013.



Respondent is hereby **ORDERED** to provide proof of a screening report on or before **January 26, 2013**, containing an analysis of respondent's blood and/or urine obtained not more than 10 days previously.
