On October 9, 2009, respondent Nolan Del Campo filed a motion for relief from costs imposed by Supreme Court order no. S172346, filed June 16, 2009. The motion was made on the grounds of hardship. (Rules Proc. of State Bar, rule 282(b)(2).) The Office of the Chief Trial Counsel (State Bar), by Treva Stewart, filed opposition thereto on October 24, 2009.

Having considered the parties' contentions and good cause appearing, the court GRANTS the motion and orders that respondent pay one-fifth of the costs awarded in Supreme Court order no. S172346 with his membership fees for each of the years 2011, 2012, 2013, 2014 and 2015. It is further ordered that if respondent fails to pay any installment of disciplinary costs within the time provided herein or as may be modified by the State Bar Court pursuant to section 6086.10, subdivision (c), the remaining balance of the costs is due and payable immediately unless relief has been granted under the Rules of Procedure of the State Bar of California (Rules Proc. of State Bar, rule 286). The payment of costs is enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.


