On July 11, 2012, the State Bar of California, Office of the Chief Trial Counsel, by and through deputy trial counsel Ashod Mooradian and respondent Nicholas Charles Rowley, represented by David A. Clare, jointly stipulated to modify the Stipulation Re: Facts, Conclusions of Law and Disposition and Order Approving, filed with the court on November 10, 2011.

On page 6 of the Stipulation, the box at paragraph E.(8) was checked. Paragraph E.(8) obligated the respondent to comply with all conditions of probation imposed in the underlying criminal matter. However, there was in fact no underlying criminal proceeding. Therefore, the checking of the box at paragraph E.(8) was incorrect.

GOOD CAUSE APPEARING THEREFOR, the motion is **GRANTED**. The error in the stipulation is corrected such that **the box at paragraph E.(8) is deemed to be not checked**.


