ORDER

After receiving notice that respondent had not passed the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination within the time prescribed in the Supreme Court order filed December 15, 2009, we ordered respondent suspended effective February 22, 2011, pending proof of passage. On January 28, 2011, respondent filed a motion requesting an extension of time to pass the examination. On February 2, 2011, the Office of Probation filed its opposition. On February 9, 2011, we denied respondent's motion and modified the effective date of respondent's suspension to March 1, 2011. On February 24, 2011, respondent filed another motion to delay or temporarily stay the actual suspension.

The order of suspension effective March 1, 2011, is temporarily stayed so that the full review department may act upon respondent's motion together with the State Bar's response, if any. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 9.10(b).) As soon as a response is filed or the time to file a response has expired, the Review Department will rule on respondent's motion, which if denied will result in respondent's immediate suspension and thus respondent should take all necessary steps to prepare for this contingency.


