On August 9, 2013, petitioner Thomas Ralph Mitchell filed a brief seeking an extension of time to pay the 2013 portion of the disciplinary costs owed in the above-listed matter.¹ Petitioner's motion was based on financial hardship. On August 14, 2013, the Office of Probation of the State Bar of California filed a non-opposition to the motion.

Good cause having been shown, petitioner's motion for extension of time to pay the 2013 portion of disciplinary costs is **GRANTED**.²

The court orders that petitioner is not required to pay the 2013 portion of the assessed disciplinary costs (one-fifth of \$1,159.50) as previously ordered in this court's February 16, 2011 Order Granting Extension of Time to Pay Costs; but he must pay two-fifths of the \$1,159.50

² The court acknowledges that this is the third time petitioner has been granted an extension of time to pay costs in this matter.


disciplinary costs assessed in this matter with his annual State Bar membership fees for 2014.
(Bus. & Prof. Code, section 6086.10, subd. (c).)

All other terms and conditions remain as previously ordered by the California Supreme Court and as modified by this court in its February 24, 2010 and February 16, 2011 orders.

The court further orders that if petitioner fails to pay any installment of disciplinary costs within the time provided herein or as may be modified by the State Bar Court under Business and Professions Code section 6086.10, subdivision (c), the remaining balance of the costs is due and payable immediately. The payment of costs remains enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
