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

Since respondent David Gonzalez has been convicted of violating Penal Code sections 550, subdivision (b)(1) (insurance fraud) and 487, subdivision (a) (grand theft), misdemeanors involving moral turpitude,¹ it is ordered pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6102 that respondent be suspended from the practice of law effective February 21, 2011, pending final disposition of this proceeding. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 9.10(a).) It is also ordered that respondent comply with California Rules of Court, rule 9.20, and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 days, respectively, after the effective date of this suspension.

As the judgment of conviction is final and it appearing that the statutory criteria for summary disbarment are not met, this case is referred to the hearing department for a hearing and decision recommending the discipline to be imposed.
