

## IN THE MATTER OF THOMAS J. HASTERT

Since respondent **THOMAS J. HASTERT, State Bar Number 143101**, has been convicted of violating Penal Code sections 487 and 506, felonies involving moral turpitude, Corporations Code sections 25110 and 25540, felonies which may or may not involve moral turpitude, and Corporations Code sections 25401 and 25540, felonies, under the authority of rule 9.10(a), California Rules of Court, it is ordered pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6102 that he be suspended from the practice of law effective October 12, 2009, pending final disposition of this proceeding. It is further ordered that he comply with rule 9.20, California Rules of Court, and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 days, respectively, after the effective date of this suspension.
