TO ALL PARTIES AND COUNSEL IN THE ABOVE ENTITLED MATTER:

On July 12, 2010, petitioner **Arleen Dorothy Russo** filed a motion for relief from or extension of time to pay disciplinary costs based on financial hardship. (Rules Proc. of State Bar, rule 282.)

The Office of the Chief Trial Counsel of the State Bar of California does not oppose an extension of time to pay costs in equal installments over the next three years.

ACCORDINGLY, in view of petitioner's financial hardship and good cause appearing, the court hereby **GRANTS** her motion for extension of time to pay disciplinary costs.

The court **ORDERS** that petitioner's time during which to pay the disciplinary costs be extended to three equal installments: one-third of said costs be paid with membership fees for the years 2011, 2012 and 2013. It is further ordered that if petitioner fails to pay any installment within the time provided herein or as may be modified by the State Bar Court pursuant to
