

Since respondent Thomas Victor Dillon, State Bar Number 236380, has been convicted of violating Health and Safety Code section 11173, subdivision (a)(1) (obtaining or attempting to obtain a controlled substance by fraud),<sup>1</sup> a felony involving moral turpitude, it is ordered pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6102 that respondent be suspended from the practice of law effective March 15, 2013, pending final disposition of this proceeding. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 9.10(a).) It is further ordered that respondent comply with California Rules of Court, rule 9.20, and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 days, respectively, after the effective date of this suspension.
