In the Matter of ROBERT ALAN PFAFF

a Member of the State Bar of California

Respondent Robert Alan Pfaff, State Bar number 93439, has been convicted of violating title 18 United States Code section 371, conspiracy to (1) defraud the United States (a crime which may or may not involve moral turpitude); and (2) commit the following offenses against the United States: violation of title 26 United States Code sections 7206(1) (filing a false tax return, a crime which involves moral turpitude) and 7201 (tax evasion, a crime for which there is probable cause to believe that it involves moral turpitude); and title 18 United States Code sections 1341 ([mail fraud] and 1343 [wire fraud], crimes which involve moral turpitude).

As the violation of title 18 United States Code section 371 is a felony and the crimes respondent conspired to commit against the United States involve moral turpitude or there is probable cause to believe that moral turpitude is involved, under the authority of rule 9.10(a), California Rules of Court, it is ordered pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6102 that respondent be suspended from the practice of law effective March 29, 2010, pending final

disposition of this proceeding. It is further ordered that respondent comply with rule 9.20, California Rules of Court, and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 days, respectively, after the effective date of this suspension.


