

On July 22, 2013, respondent Jon Eric Gelb filed a motion for an extension of time to pay discipline costs or, in the alternative, for relief from paying the costs in whole. The State Bar does not oppose the extension of time but does oppose relief in whole.

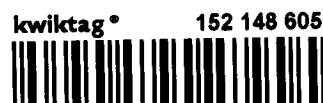
Having carefully considered the motion and response, the court concludes that good cause is shown to extend the time for payment of the costs, but not to relieve respondent in whole from paying them. Accordingly, the costs ordered in this case must be paid on or before the due date for respondent's membership fees for 2014. The payment of the costs remains enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.


