

Since respondent Eric Francis Fagan has been convicted of violating Penal Code sections 187, subdivision (a) (murder) and 664/187, subdivision (a) (attempted murder), felonies involving moral turpitude, it is ordered pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6102 that respondent be suspended from the practice of law effective March 25, 2013, pending final disposition of this proceeding. 
