Since respondent Leon Rubin Laufer, State Bar Number 100995, has been convicted of violating Penal Code section 549 (false or fraudulent claims against insurers; solicitation, acceptance or referral of business), a misdemeanor for which there is probable cause to believe involves moral turpitude, it is ordered pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6102 that respondent be suspended from the practice of law effective July 8, 2011, pending final disposition of this proceeding.
