Since respondent Patience Nooney VanZandt, State Bar Number 179151, has been convicted of violating Health & Safety Code section 11359 (possession of marijuana for sale), a felony that may or may not involve moral turpitude,¹ under the authority of rule 9.10(a), California Rules of Court, it is ordered pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6102 that respondent be suspended from the practice of law effective December 18, 2009, pending final disposition of this proceeding. It is further ordered that respondent comply with rule 9.20, California Rules of Court, and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 days, respectively, after the effective date of this suspension.

¹ VanZandt was also convicted of violating Health & Safety Code section 11377, subdivision (a), (possession of controlled substance), a misdemeanor that may or may not involve moral turpitude.
