On October 24, 2011, Respondent filed a request for an extension of time during which he may present proof of passage of the MPRE. On October 26, 2011, the State Bar filed a statement of opposition to the request, noting that the motion should have been captioned in case no. 09-H-19145, rather than in case no. 05-O-03000, a prior reproval matter that has now terminated completely.

Because it is clear that Respondent's reference to the wrong case number was simply a clerical mistake, this court will deem the motion filed in the above-captioned case. In this case, Respondent was ordered to present proof of his passage of the MPRE by "not later than November 12, 2011." (Stipulation, p. 6.) Although Respondent is scheduled to take the November 5, 2011 examination, after having previously taken the examination unsuccessfully on three prior occasions, it is clear that he will not be able to report the results of that examination by the November 12 deadline.

GOOD CAUSE APPEARING and pursuant to rule 9.10(b) of the California Rules of Court, the court GRANTS Respondent's motion to extend the time during which he may present proof of passage of the MPRE. Accordingly, the time in which Respondent must present proof to the Office of Probation of his passage of the MPRE is extended until ten (10) calendar days after the results of the November, 2011 MPRE are released.

**IT IS SO ORDERED.**


