On May 20, 2010, respondent Patrick John Carter filed a motion for relief from costs imposed by the Supreme Court. The motion was made on the grounds of hardship. (Rules Proc. of State Bar, rule 282(b)(2).) The State Bar does not oppose the motion.

Having considered the parties' contentions and good cause appearing, the motion is GRANTED. Respondent is ordered to pay the costs awarded by the Supreme Court by order filed March 11, 2010, in case number S179530, in monthly installments of \$200 per month, commencing on July 1, 2010, and continuing until paid in full. It is further ordered that if respondent fails to pay any installment of disciplinary costs within the time provided herein or as may be modified by the State Bar Court pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6086.10, subdivision (c), the remaining balance of the costs is due and payable immediately unless relief has been granted under the Rules of Procedure of the State Bar of California. (See Rules Proc. of State Bar, rule 286.) The payment of costs is enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.
