Introduction

This matter is before the court on respondent Quentin Sims' August 3, 2011, motion for an extension of time to take State Bar Ethics School and Trust Accounting School; relief from disciplinary costs; extension of time to pay disciplinary costs; and extension of time to pay 2010, 2011, and 2012 State Bar dues. The State Bar of California ("State Bar") filed responses in non-opposition, in part, and opposition in part on August 9, 2011, and August 11, 2011. Respondent is representing himself in this matter. The State Bar is represented by Deputy Trial Counsel Mia Ellis and Supervisior Trial Counsel Terri Goldade.

After a careful review of the respondent's motion and the responses, the court GRANTS the motion to extend time: to take State Bar Ethics School and Trust Accounting School; and, to pay discipline costs, good cause having been shown. The court DENIES respondent's motion for complete relief from disciplinary costs, no good cause having been shown. The court



DENIES the motion for an extension of time to pay 2010, 2011, and 2012, State Bar dues for lack of jurisdiction.

Accordingly, Respondent must provide proof of successful completion of State Bar Ethics School and State Bar Trust Accounting School to the State Bar Office of Probation by March 31, 2012

The court orders a one year extension of time for Respondent to pay the ordered disciplinary costs.
