On December 17, 2015, respondent timely filed a motion in this case, seeking to modify a condition of her private reproof, which became effective on January 2, 2015. Specifically, respondent requests that she be allowed an additional six months of time to provide proof of passage of the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination (MPRE). In her motion, respondent contends that she was preoccupied with health problems, which, coupled with oversights on her part, resulted in her being unable to take the three previous MPREs. The Office of Probation filed a response to the motion on December 28, 2015, indicating that it opposed the motion to extend time, and contending that respondent's contentions lack specificity, and additionally that respondent has not indicated that she has registered for the next MPRE, scheduled to take place on March 19, 2016.¹

GOOD CAUSE APPEARING, respondent's motion is GRANTED, and the condition of private reproof in this case is modified, such that respondent is now required to provide proof of passage of the MPRE by July 1, 2016.

IT IS SO ORDERED.


