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On September 9, 2011, respondent GREGORY ALLEN PAVIA filed a petition for payment plan. Respondent's motion was based on financial hardship. On September 12, 2011, Deputy Trial Counsel Margaret Warren of the Office of the Chief Trial Counsel of the State Bar of California ("State Bar") filed its response in non-opposition.

After careful consideration of respondent's petition and the State Bar's non-opposition, the court GRANTS the motion, good cause having been shown. The court orders that respondent's time to pay the disciplinary costs associated with the above captioned matter be extended. The respondent must pay disciplinary costs (\$6,060) in equal amounts (\$2,020) with his annual State Bar membership fees prior to February 1<sup>st</sup> for the following years: 2013, 2014, and 2015. The court further ORDERS that, if respondent fails to pay any installment of disciplinary costs within the time provided herein or as may be modified by the State Bar Court



pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6086.10, subdivision (c), the remaining balance of the costs is due and payable immediately unless relief has been granted under the Rules of Procedure of the State Bar of California (Rules Proc. of State Bar, rule 5.130(B)). The payment of costs remains enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.


