On April 22, 2011, Respondent Douglas W. Davis (Respondent) filed a third amended request for an extension of time during which he may present proof of passage of the MPRE. His initial request was filed on April 6, 2011. The time for him to present proof of passage of the MPRE is currently scheduled to expire in April 2011.

On April 25, 2011, the State Bar filed a statement of non-opposition to the request that the time for presenting proof of passage of the MPRE be extended until after the August examination.

GOOD CAUSE APPEARING and pursuant to rule 9.10(b) of the California Rules of Court, the court GRANTS Respondent's motion to extend the time during which he may present proof of passage of the MPRE. Accordingly, the time in which Respondent must present proof to the Office of Probation of his passage of the MPRE is extended until ten (10) calendar days after the results of the August, 2011 MPRE are released.
