On September 24, 2013, respondent Lorraine Dickson filed a motion for an extension to take and pass the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination (MPRE). On October 1, 2013, the Office of Probation of the State Bar filed its opposition to the motion, and a request for judicial notice of Dickson's pending status and other matters.

Finding no good cause, the motion for an extension is denied. We grant the Office of Probation's request for judicial notice.
