## HEARING DEPARTMENT - LOS ANGELES



On June 28, 2013, respondent Lorraine Dickson filed a motion for relief in whole from the payment of discipline costs or for an extension of time to pay them, and for a stay of the suspension imposed by the Supreme Court for failing to pay her membership fees. The State Bar opposes the motion. Respondent's financial condition warrants an extension of time to pay the discipline costs, but not for relief in whole. The request for an extension is therefore granted. The costs imposed in this case must be paid on or before January 31, 2014.

The request to stay the Supreme Court's suspension order is referred to the review department for ruling. (Rules Proc. of State Bar, rule 5.161(A).)
