On August 18, 2011, respondent William F. Bosque, Jr. filed a motion seeking an extension of time in which to provide proof of passage of the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination (MPRE) and attendance of Ethics School. On August 22, 2011, respondent filed an amended motion. Respondent took the August 5, 2011 MPRE and is awaiting results. Respondent attended Ethics School on August 18, 2011 and is awaiting the distribution of the completion certificate. On August 24, 2011, the Office of Probation, by Terrie D. Goldade, filed a non-opposition response thereto.

Having considered the parties' contentions and good cause appearing, the court GRANTS the motion. Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that the time in which respondent must successfully complete the MPRE is extended until the results of the August 2011 MPRE are released. Respondent must provide satisfactory proof of the successful completion of the MPRE to the Office of Probation no later than 10 days after the results of the MPRE are received or September 21, 2011 whichever is later. Similarly, Respondent must provide the certificate of

completion of the August 18, 2011 Ethics School session to the Office of Probation no later than 10 days after the issuance of such certificate or September 21, 2011, whichever is later.
