On October 8, 2015, respondent filed a motion seeking to modify the terms of his probation in this matter. Specifically, respondent requests that his requirement to pay restitution and interest owed to Ms. Norma Garcia be changed so that respondent pays the Client Security Fund (CSF) on Ms. Garcia's behalf as he has been unable to locate her despite due diligence. Attached to respondent's motion is his declaration, signed under penalty of perjury, detailing the actions respondent took in order to locate Ms. Garcia. On October 14, 2015, respondent filed a supplemental declaration, signed under penalty of perjury, detailing additional steps he took in locating Ms. Garcia.

On October 15, 2015, the Office of Probation filed a response, indicating that it did not oppose respondent's motion, after review of respondent's motion and his supplemental declaration.

GOOD CAUSE APPEARING, respondent's motion is GRANTED, and the terms of respondent's probation are hereby amended, such that his restitution obligation, including interest owed, shall be paid by respondent to CSF, on behalf of Ms. Norma Garcia.

IT IS SO ORDERED.


