**ORDER VACATING DEFAULT AND

NOTICE OF DISCIPLINARY CHARGES**

The Notice of Disciplinary Charges (“NDC”) in this matter was filed January 18, 2011. On February 14, 2011, the Office of the Chief Trial Counsel filed a motion for entry of default, on March 2, 2011, default was entered, and respondent was enrolled inactive on March 5, 2011.

The NDC did not contain the proper language set forth in rule 5.80(A) of the Rules of Procedure of the State Bar of California (“rule(s)”). Because the NDC was improper, it was also improper to enter default.

GOOD CAUSE APPEARING THEREFOR, the entry of respondent’s default is **VACATED**; the order enrolling respondent involuntarily inactive is **VACATED**, and the Office of the Chief Trial Counsel is **ORDERED** to file and serve an amended NDC within 15 days after


