

In the Matter of ROBERT JEFF CLASTER
a Member of the State Bar of California

Robert Jeff Claster, State Bar Number 70548, has been convicted of violating Penal Code section 646.9 subdivision (a) (stalking), a felony. The review department determines that this violation is not a crime which inherently involves moral turpitude, but may involve moral turpitude or other misconduct warranting discipline based on the facts and circumstances surrounding the conviction. Because the criteria for summary disbarment are not satisfied, we deny the State Bar's motion requesting summary disbarment.

As a result of his felony conviction, it is ordered that Claster be suspended from the practice of law effective September 6, 2010, pending final disposition of this proceeding. (Bus. & Prof. Code, § 6102.) It is also ordered that he comply with rule 9.20, California Rules of Court, and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 days, respectively, after the effective date of this suspension.

As the judgment of conviction is final, this case is referred to the hearing department for a hearing and decision as to whether the facts and circumstances surrounding the violation(s) of which Claster was convicted involved moral turpitude or other misconduct warranting discipline, and if so found, the discipline to be imposed.


