**ORDER GRANTING RESPONDENT'S  
MOTION FOR TEMPORARY  
MODIFICATION OF PROBATION**



On June 13, 2012, respondent Thomas Wilder filed a second amended motion for modification of probation. The State Bar of California ("State Bar") filed a response in non-opposition on June 22, 2012. Respondent is representing himself in this matter. The State Bar is represented by Supervising Attorney Terri Goldade.

After a careful review of the motion and response, the court **GRANTS** the motion for modification of probation, good cause having been shown. Accordingly, Respondent's probation is modified as follows:

Respondent is to attend therapy twice per month (2 times per month) with Michael Casey, MFT, until Respondent finds employment. When Respondent finds employment, he must notify the Office of Probation and reinstate therapy twice per month with a psychologist or social worker.


