Since respondent Eduardo Brito Leaton, Jr. has been convicted of violating Penal Code sections 288.4, subdivision (b) (contact of a minor with intent to commit a sexual offense) and 311.4, subdivision (c) (use of a minor to perform prohibited acts), felonies, under the authority of rule 9.10(a), California Rules of Court, it is ordered pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6102 that respondent be suspended from the practice of law effective December 10, 2010, pending final disposition of this proceeding. It is further ordered that respondent comply with rule 9.20, California Rules of Court, and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 days, respectively, after the effective date of this suspension.

As these crimes have not previously been classified, the review department reserves the moral character classification at this time. The parties are invited to file briefs within 20 days of the date of service of this order addressing the issue of whether or not a violation of these crimes involve moral turpitude per se.
