


First, the offense is a felony. (Bus. & Prof. Code, § 6102, subd. (b).) Second, the elements of the offense include the making under oath of a knowingly and fraudulently false material statement. (*Metheany v. United States* (9th Cir.1968) 390 F.2d 559, 561.) Such an offense involves moral turpitude per se. (See *In re Kristovich* (1976) 18 Cal.3d 468, 472 [perjury, “which entails a willful false statement, contrary to oath, as to a material matter which one knows to be false” involves moral turpitude].)

When an attorney’s conviction meets the requirements of Business and Professions Code section 6102, subdivision (c), “the attorney is not entitled to a State Bar Court hearing to determine whether lesser discipline is called for.” (*In re Paguirigan* (2001) 25 Cal.4th 1, 7.) Disbarment is mandatory. (*Id.* at p. 9.)

We therefore recommend that John Joseph Zodrow, State Bar number 199349, be disbarred from the practice of law in this state. We also recommend that Zodrow be ordered to comply with rule 9.20 of the California Rules of Court and to perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 days, respectively, after the effective date of the Supreme Court’s order. Finally, we recommend that the costs be awarded to the State Bar in accordance with section 6086.10 of the Business and Professions Code and that such costs be enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.


