On November 3, 2010, the State Bar transmitted the criminal record showing Albert Ramirez Zarate was convicted of violating Virginia Code section 18.2-96 (petty larceny), a misdemeanor involving moral turpitude. On November 24, 2010, we ordered the parties to show cause before December 6, 2010, why Zarate should not be suspended from the practice of law, pending final disposition of this proceeding. The State Bar filed a brief, recommending that Zarate be suspended. Zarate failed to file a brief.

Since Zarate has been convicted of a crime involving moral turpitude, under the authority of rule 9.10(a), California Rules of Court, it is ordered Zarate be suspended from the practice of law effective January 5, 2011, pending final disposition of this proceeding. It is also ordered that Zarate comply with rule 9.20, California Rules of Court, and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 days, respectively, after the effective date of this suspension. As the judgment of conviction is final and it appearing that the statutory criteria for summary disbarment are not met, this case is referred to the hearing department for a hearing and decision recommending the discipline to be imposed.
