On September 20, 2012, respondent Frear S. Schmid filed a petition/motion concerning filing of petition for review of order denying relief from costs and permitting the late filing thereof. We granted the petition for interlocutory review, and the State Bar filed its response on November 9, 2012. Respondent filed a reply on November 20, 2012.

Pursuant to Code of Civil Procedure section 1033.5, subdivision (b)(5), the transcripts of court proceedings are not allowable costs except when ordered by the court. No such order was issued in this case, and since that item is not otherwise expressly authorized by law, the State Bar is not entitled to recover for that expenditure. All other objections raised in respondent's motion are denied.

Thus, respondent's motion is granted, in part, and the State Bar's request for \$1,835.40 for transcripts in the underlying criminal case is denied. It is hereby ordered that respondent's total disciplinary costs in this matter are \$18,130.46.
