Introduction

This matter is before the court on respondent BRIAN D. GARD's July 1, 2013, motion for relief from disciplinary costs, or an extension of time to pay disciplinary costs. The State Bar of California ("State Bar") filed a response in partial opposition on July 29, 2013. Respondent is representing himself in this matter. The State Bar is represented by Deputy Trial Counsel Monique Miller.

After a careful review of respondent's motion and the response, the court DENIES the motion for relief of costs, no good cause having been shown. The court GRANTS the motion for an extension of time to pay costs, good cause having been shown. Accordingly, time is extended for respondent to pay disciplinary costs. Respondent must pay half the disciplinary costs with his 2015 State Bar membership fees and half the disciplinary costs with his 2016 State Bar

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membership fees.


