On April 11, 2014, respondent Steven Craig Feldman filed a motion for an extension of time to pay disciplinary costs imposed in Supreme Court order no. S200196 (State Bar Court case nos. 10-O-00157 (10-O-01887; 10-O-04640;10-O-04641; 10-O-04648;10-O-4933; 10-O-06919);12-O-12764; 12-O-16854 (Cons.)) on the grounds of financial hardship. On April 14, 2014, the Office of the Chief Trial Counsel of the State Bar of California (State Bar), by Timothy G. Byer, filed a response indicating no opposition to establishing a payment plan for the disciplinary costs.

Having considered the parties' contentions and good cause appearing, the motion is GRANTED. Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that respondent has established sufficient hardship to grant him an extension of time to pay the costs in four annual installments as set forth below.

Respondent Steven Craig Feldman must pay one-fourth of the costs with his State Bar of California membership fees for each of the years 2015, 2016, 2017 and 2018. If he fails to pay any installment as described above, or as may be hereafter modified by the State Bar Court, the remaining unpaid balance of the costs is due and payable immediately. Until they are paid in

full, the costs remain enforceable both as provided in Business and Professions Code section 6140.7 and as a money judgment.


