In the event respondent fails to make any installment payment or submits any installment payment more than 10 days after the due date without the prior written approval of the State Bar's Office of Probation, the unpaid balance of the discipline costs shall become immediately due and the State Bar may obtain and seek to collect a judgment for that unpaid balance.
