On February 22, 2012, respondent James J. Murray (respondent) filed a Petition to Amend Order Re Restitution. The State Bar filed a response to the motion indicating that it did not oppose the petition.

After considering respondent's petition and the State Bar's response thereto, and good cause having been shown, the court grants respondent's petition, and orders that the probation condition requiring that respondent pay restitution to Isiak Moyosore is modified to require that respondent pay the restitution set forth in the parties' stipulation filed on December 20, 2010, to the State Bar's Client Security Fund (rather than to Mr. Moyosore) in light of the fact that both the State Bar and respondent have been unable to locate Mr. Moyosore after diligent efforts. The court therefore orders that within 10 days after service of this order, respondent must pay the



required restitution to the Client Security Fund and provide proof of such payment to the State Bar's Office of Probation within the same period.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
