To provide respondent adequate time to give proper notice to all concerned parties due to his current heavy caseload, respondent is ordered to be enrolled as an inactive member effective May 15, 2012, instead of the customary three days, after service by mail of the court's March 19, 2012 Decision and Order of Involuntary Inactive Enrollment. (Rules Proc. of State Bar, rule 5.111(D).)

This Order Modifying Order of Involuntary Inactive Enrollment is effective, nunc protunc, as of March 19, 2012.
