On December 21, 2010, respondent Richard Alan Brubaker filed a petition for transfer to active enrollment.<sup>1</sup> On January 13, 2011, the Office of the Chief Trial Counsel (State Bar), by Monique T. Miller, filed a response indicating no opposition to the petition.

Having considered the parties' contentions and the evidence submitted, the court finds by clear and convincing evidence that there is no longer a basis for respondent's inactive enrollment. Accordingly, the petition is granted and the order of inactive enrollment is terminated, effective on the date of service of this order. (See former rule 444(a), Rules Proc. of State Bar.<sup>2</sup>)

<sup>1</sup> By order filed July 30, 2007, respondent was enrolled inactive pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6007(B)(2).

<sup>2</sup> Since this matter was filed in 2010, the court has determined that the "new" Rules of Procedure of the State Bar, effective January 1, 2011, are not applicable as an injustice would otherwise result. All future references to rule are to the former Rules of Procedure.

The parties are cautioned that this transfer to active enrollment does not operate to relieve respondent of any suspension imposed for any reason or of any other independent restriction that may exist regarding his right to practice law. (Rule 445.)


