Since respondent Steven Patrick Mancuso has been convicted of violating 18 United States Code section 371, conspiracy to: (1) defraud the United States (a felony which may or may not involve moral turpitude); (2) violate 42 United States Code sections 7412 and 7413(c) (the Clean Air Act, a felony); (3) violate 42 United States Code section 9603 (the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act, a felony); and (4) violate 18 United States Code 1341 (mail fraud, a felony which involves moral turpitude) it is ordered pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6102 that respondent be suspended from the practice of law effective April 24, 2011, pending final disposition of this proceeding. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 9.10(a).) It is further ordered that respondent comply with California Rules of Court, rule 9.20, and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 days, respectively, after the effective date of this suspension.

The review department reserves the moral character classification of 42 United States Code sections 7412, 7413(c) and 9603.
