We have received evidence that respondent Fred Jay Grossblatt, State Bar Number 82234, has been convicted of violating:

- 1. Oregon Revised Statute (ORS) 475.840(3)(b) (possession of a controlled substance), a felony;
- 2. ORS 164.225 (burglary in the first degree; two counts),
- 3. ORS 165.800 (identity theft), and
- 4. ORS 164.043 (theft in the third degree), a misdemeanor.

In light of his felony conviction under ORS 475.840(3)(b), it is ordered pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6102 that Grossblatt be suspended from the practice of law effective March 23, 2011, pending final disposition of this proceeding. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 9.10(a).)¹

The parties are ordered to file briefs within 20 days of the date of service of this order addressing: 1) whether or not a violation of section 164.225, 165.800, 475.840(3)(b), or 164.043 involves moral turpitude per se, and 2) whether or not the violations of sections 164.225 and 165.800 would necessarily constitute felonies under Business and Professions Code section 6102, subdivision (d).

¹As a result of a prior conviction, on February 18, 2011, we ordered that Grossblatt be placed on interim suspension and comply California Rules of Court, rule 9.20. Accordingly, we will not require compliance with rule 9.20 again.
