The Review Department reserves the moral turpitude classification of Alaska Statutes sections 11.61.123(a)(f)(2) and 11.61.127(a) and orders the parties to file briefs within 20 days of the date of service of this order addressing the issue of whether or not a violation of these sections involves moral turpitude per se.
