ORDER

Since respondent Corey Martin Kagan has been convicted of violating Health and Safety Code section 11350, subdivision (a) (possession of a controlled substance), a felony which may or may not involve moral turpitude, it is ordered pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6102 that respondent be suspended from the practice of law effective June 12, 2011, pending final disposition of this proceeding. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 9.10(a).)

Since we ordered respondent to comply with California Rules of Court, rule 9.20 in case nos. 10-C-07037, 10-C-07038 and 10-C-07163, we do not order him to do so in this case. We will take no further action pending the submission of evidence of finality of the conviction or respondent's waiver of finality pursuant to rule 5.344(B) of the Rules of Procedure of the State Bar.
