

Since respondent Owen Riki Onouye, State Bar Number 174580, has been convicted of violating Nebraska Statutes section 28-416 (possession of a controlled substance with intent to distribute or deliver), a felony, it is ordered pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6102 that respondent be suspended from the practice of law effective August 26, 2011, pending final disposition of this proceeding. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 9.10(a).) It is further ordered that respondent comply with California Rules of Court, rule 9.20, and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 days, respectively, after the effective date of this suspension.

The Review Department reserves the moral turpitude classification of Nebraska Statutes section 28-416 and orders the parties to file briefs within 20 days of the date of service of this order addressing the issue of whether or not a violation of this section involves moral turpitude per se.


