

Respondent Felicia Faye Blakley, State Bar Number 139374, has been convicted of violating: (1) Penal Code section 69 (obstructing or resisting executive officer), a felony that that may or may not involve moral turpitude, and (2) Penal Code section 594, subdivision (a)(b)(2)(A) (vandalism causing less than \$400 damage), a misdemeanor that may or may not involve moral turpitude.

As a result of the felony conviction, it is ordered pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 6102 that respondent be suspended from the practice of law effective September 26, 2011, pending final disposition of this proceeding. (Cal. Rules of Court, rule 9.10(a).) It is further ordered that respondent comply with California Rules of Court, rule 9.20, and perform the acts specified in subdivisions (a) and (c) of that rule within 30 and 40 days, respectively, after the effective date of this suspension. Although the conviction was entered on December 26, 2007, we have not received evidence of finality. We will take no further action at this time pending the submission of evidence of finality of the conviction or respondent's waiver of finality pursuant to rule 603(b) of the Rules of Procedure of the State Bar.


